CAMDEN COUNTY

HOME IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

Income eligible homeowners may be eligible for a 0% interest, deferred payment loan program which provides qualified applicants with funding for needed home repairs. Eligible work items include things such as: exterior, interior, roof, siding, windows, heating systems and electrical systems.

The program may not be used for room additions or upgrades.

(Roof, HVAC & Handicap Ramps are forgivable after 10 years)

How does the program work?

If an applicant is deemed eligible, their project is assigned to an approved contractor. Staff monitors all work to ensure it is done correctly and within the guidelines of the program.

What does it cost?

Projects will result in a 0% interest loan in the form of a lien placed on the property. With this lien, no payments are required until the time of sale or a change in ownership.

Who is eligible for the program?

Homeowners must reside within one of the eligible municipalities and the household income must be lower than the income limits below.

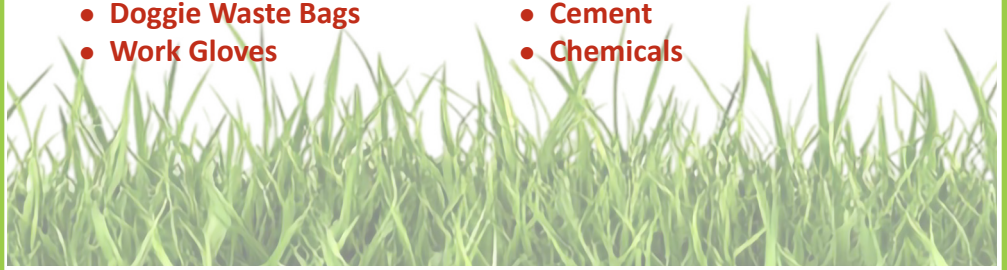

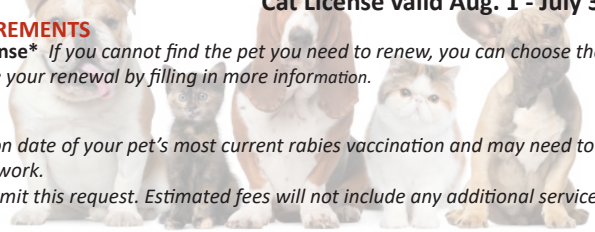

Invasives in the Home Landscape

With homeowners tackling landscapes after a long winter, the Cherry Hill Environmental Board (CHEB) has a few tips to offer for the invasive plant species that may be lurking in your yard. Invasive plants (and other species) are not native to our ecosystem and can quickly displace natives through competition. Because they aren't local, they typically have fewer to no natural controls, and can aggressively reproduce and replace native plants that our wildlife depend on. They can be widespread and should not be confused with weeds.



Note that invasives are for sale at local garden centers and include common varieties such as English ivy, wisteria, periwinkle, Japanese honeysuckle, and Callery pear (trees). Residents should avoid planting invasives altogether. Check out the **Do Not Plant** list at fohvos.info, the website for the NJ Invasive Species Strike Team. Second, identify non-natives on your property to determine if they are invasive, and remove wherever possible. The EDDMapS app can help you identify invasives in your yard.

English ivy (*Hedera helix*)

An evergreen climbing vine often found as ground cover, it climbs trees in search of light, eventually killing branches and suffocating trees by preventing photosynthesis. To remove ground ivy, pull it up by the roots, or smother with wood chips or other biodegradable material and leave for two growing seasons. For ivy on trees, cut vines near the base to kill upper portions and protect the bark.

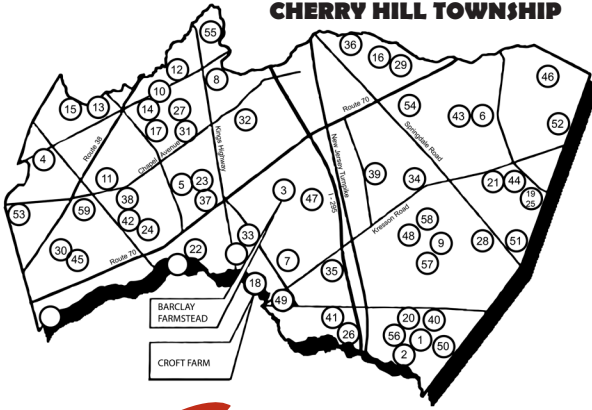
