Four Year Universities: Educational institutions which offers a 4-year, degree-granting program, such as bachelors degree programs.












Community Colleges: Educational institutions known also as junior colleges. They offer two-year associates degree programs as well as workforce training, certificate programs, and continuing education. May also offer the option to transfer credits to 4-year colleges.

Trade/Technical Schools: Educational institutions also known as vocational schools, who offer programs designed to provide training for specific technical or vocational tasks, such as skilled trades, nursing, or computer technology.
